

## "Night Cooling" Function in: Next Generation HERU Heat Recovery Ventilation Systems



## **To Activate Night Cooling**

Night cooling is a temperature regulated boost without heat recovery, where the unit is cooled with cold outdoor air as needed.

Night cooling is activated when the exhaust air temperature is higher than **Exhaust Air High** and outdoor temperature is colder than **IN/OUT Difference**.

Night Cooling is deactivated when the exhaust air temperature is lower than **Exhaust Air Low** or the outdoor temperature is warmer than the **IN/OUT Difference.** 

**Temperature Evaluation Rest Mode** must be activated if the unit is in standby mode or night cooling is requested. **Temperature Evaluation Rest Mode** checks whether the criteria for activating night cooling has been fulfilled within the set time intervals.

No preparations are required.

- 1. Open the main menu and select **Service**
- 2. Log in and enter code **1199**
- 3. Press Ok
- 4. Select Setup
- 5. Scroll down to **Night Cooling** and press the **Activate** Icon
- 6. Enter the selected value
- 7. If the unit is in standby and night cooling has been requested, activate **Temperature Evaluation Rest Mode**
- 8. Enter the selected value
- 9. Return to the main menu by pressing the main menu button in the upper left corner
- 10. Return to the home screen by pressing the **X** button in the upper left corner
